

NGS Standard Query Naming Conventions

Agreed upon at the NGS User Group Workshop

The query name will contain 10 characters with the following structure:

XNNNNNNORC

The X identifies the module:

C = Case Management
E = Early Start
D = Clinical
F = Fiscal
M = Miscellaneous
O = Operations
P = Purchase of Services
R = Resource/Vendor
S = Self Determined System
T = Trust
W = Federal Program

The N represents the sequential number assigned:
000001

** The O represents the type of output the query produces:

D = Display
R = Report
F = File output to disk
C = Text/CSV data to file
X = XML data to file
T = Text Report
H = HTML report
P = PD Report

** these are all of the output query options that the NGS software allow

The RC represents the originating Regional Center, examples:

SG = San Gabriel/Pomona
SD = San Diego RC
FN = Far Northern
NL = North LA
